

**The project « Keeping and attracting skilled labour force in Central and Eastern European countries » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"**

**Participation:** The project involved 238 citizens, notably 62 participants from the city of Mórahalom (**Hungary**), 47 participants from the city of Sanmartin (**Romania**), 40 participants from the city of Jimbolia (**Romania**), 45 participants from the city of Temerin (**Serbia**) and 44 participants from the city of Uniejów (**Poland**).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in Mórahalom (**Hungary**), from 12/09/2017 to 16/09/2017.

**Short description:**

The day of 13/09/2017 was dedicated to a conference with the topic of Keeping and attracting skilled labour force in Central and Eastern European countries.

The day of 14/09/2017 was dedicated to twin cities roundtable discussions where each local governments presented their local economic development programs, ongoing projects and future plans.

The day of 15/09/2017 was dedicated to twin cities site institutional visits, when the participants visited three local businesses that have a significant job-creating (and retaining) role in Mórahalom and it's neighborhood and foreign attraction area.
